
SoonerCare Members

The number of SoonerCare members diagnosed with cancer increased substantially from SFY2022 (15,059 members) to SFY2023 (22,515). Most were adults. The prevalence rate of cancer among SoonerCare members remained stable at 1.5%.

Among the 33 different types of cancer, defined by the *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision*, the most common type of cancer were secondary malignancies, followed by breast, cervix, and non-epithelial skin cancer.






Members with Cancer by Age Group SFY2023



Secondary malignancies, **breast, cervix**, and **non-epithelial cancers of the skin** were among the most prevalent types of cancer in SFY2023.

Per-member reimbursements for members with **multiple myeloma** were highest at **\$53K** average.

Cancer Prevalence Rate, Total Reimbursement, and Reimbursement per Member - Top 10 for Each Measure










demographic composition of all SoonerCare members. See details below. The black line represents the percent of total SoonerCare members.







Reimbursement Cost

While only 1.5% of SoonerCare members had cancer in SFY2022, the total reimbursement associated with their services made up 5.6% of all SoonerCare reimbursements paid in SFY2022. The cost of providing care to members with cancer is disproportionately higher than the prevalence of cancer among SoonerCare members.

The total reimbursement for members with cancer increased to \$539M in SFY2023, due not only but primarily to an increase in the SoonerCare population during this year. There was also a continued increase in per-member reimbursement.




SoonerCare Members with Cancer: Percent of Total Reimbursement Compared to Percent of SoonerCare Enrollment
