
#### SoonerCare Members

The number of members diagnosed with hypertension increased from 131,328 members in SFY2022 to 149,893 in SFY2023. Nearly all were adults.


This continued a trend established since reporting began, with the drop in SFY20-21 likely a result of COVID-19 causing underreporting.

#### Members with Hypertension by Eligibility Type SFY2023











#### **Reimbursement Cost**

The total reimbursement for services utilized for members with hypertension in SFY2023 increased significantly to \$2,689,305,327. The per-member average total reimbursement for SFY2023 rose to \$17,942, reversing a decrease in SFY2022.

Despite a prevalence rate of 10.2%, the total reimbursement for services rendered for SoonerCare members with hypertension made up 27.8% of all reimbursements paid in SFY2022. The cost of providing care to members with hypertension was disproportionately higher than the prevalence of hypertension among SoonerCare members.



SoonerCare Members with Hypertension: Percent of Total Reimbursement Compared to Percent of Total SoonerCare Enrollment


